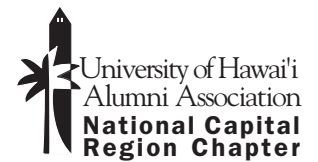

Directions to Andrews AFB Golf Course

Washington:

From The US Capitol, take South Capitol Street out of Washington. South Capitol Street changes into Suitland Parkway. Take a right onto Branch Ave/Rt 5 S. Follow Route 5 approximately 6 miles until you come to the Coventry Way exit. At the traffic light off the exit ramp, make a left and get in the right hand lane. At the next traffic light, make a right onto Old Alexandria Ferry Road. At the second traffic light make a left into the Virginia Ave Gate. For tournament participants, your name will appear on a gate list with the Gate Security Police. Proceed up to the Gate Guard for clearance on to the Base. Make your first left and the Golf Course parking lot will be on your right.

Northern Virginia:

From Fairfax, Springfield and Alexandria, take 95 north towards Baltimore. Go across the Woodrow Wilson Bridge. Take Maryland Exit 7 (Branch Ave/Rt 5 S/Waldorf). Follow Route 5 to the Coventry Way exit. At the traffic light off the exit ramp, make a left and get in the right hand lane. At the next traffic light, make a right onto Old Alexandria Ferry Road. At the second traffic light make a left into the Virginia Ave Gate. For tournament participants, your name will appear on a gate list with the Gate Security Police. Proceed up to the Gate Guard for clearance on to the Base. Make your first left and the Golf Course parking lot will be on your right.
